- 7 CONSULTANT FOR LOTM DURING INTERIM. Council expressed enthusiasm for LOTM's consultant, Penni Walsh. She will preach once a month. We have 3 very willing pastors to fill the pulpit the other 3 Sundays: Darlene Muschett, Lydia Ziauddin, and Joe Holub. Sally and Ben agreed to be in contact with Penni to welcome her.
- 8 BUILDING USE POLICY. Very lively discussion on building use policy. What's allowed, what's not. Who's allowed in after hours, etc. Part of this policy is a caution to be very careful about who has the side door code. It was decided this needed a committee to definitively work out the rules. Kevin Clarke, Ben Little, Julie Cope, Linda Wakefield, Amy Simper, Amy Watson. Council thought Karen Johns should also be on the committee because of her work with the day services ministry.
